Our agency operates under the belief that inherent in every child is the ability to succeed and thrive in life. We are committed to helping Littles (ages 5-18) access their own resourcefulness and resiliency in order to achieve their full potential.

We provide an array of impactful programs including Career Mentoring Exploration (CME), which guides high school students in discovering potential career paths; our Site-Based Program, fostering relationships between mentors and youth in schools and community centers; the Community-Based Program, pairing youth with mentors for enriching experiences that build life skills; and our STEAM Camp, which engages youth in hands-on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics activities, nurturing curiosity and critical thinking.

Supporting Big Brothers Big Sisters is a unique opportunity to invest in the future of our community. Unlike many other non-profit organizations that serve children, we do not charge fees to the families or volunteer mentors in our programs. This means 100% of our operating budget comes from donations, grants, and sponsorships. In 2024, over 50% of our revenue was generated through community support, enabling more than 25,000 mentoring hours between Littles and volunteer Bigs.

These experiences boosted Ronit's confidence and motivated him to focus on his academic growth, becoming more social and driven to excel.

A Harmonious Bond: Lukas and Logan's Story



The Site-Based Program at Big Brothers Big Sisters connects students with mentors through weekly, staff-led activities at schools or community centers. High school and adult mentors are paired with elementary or middle school youth to foster trust, growth, and confidence. At Hilltop Middle School in Long Beach, Washington, this program brought together Lukas, a spirited 6th grader, and Logan, a senior at Ilwaco High School.

Lukas joined the program during a challenging time, navigating housing insecurities and the absence of a positive male role model. Logan, drawn to mentoring as a way to explore a future in teaching, became that support. From the moment they met, their shared love of music—and the trumpet in particular—deepened their bond, and Logan's encouraging presence gave Lukas the confidence to engage!

Each week, they connected through fun and meaningful activities. Logan's support extended beyond their meetings—he attended Lukas's band concerts, practiced trumpet with him, and encouraged his academic growth. Over time, Lukas's grades and confidence improved, along with his passion for music.

Their story highlights how the Site-Based Program helps youth like Lukas overcome challenges and build bright futures, proving even an hour a week can make a lasting impact!


